Action

By When

Physical Education *Profile across school; upskilling of staff*

- Review and implement revised PE long term plan, ensuring coverage and at least 2 hours of sport per pupil per week July '16
- School wide assessment system used to track attainment and progress of all pupils From Sept '16
- Create sport display in school hall inc. sport calendar, fixture reports, photos etc. Jan '17
- Widen School Council role to advise as a Sport Crew, meeting regularly and reporting on sport fortnightly to parents and community (Twitter, school website, e-newsletter etc.) Dec '16
- Employ specialist sport coach and use specialist teacher to upskill key staff From Sept '16

Formal Activity *Increased participation in competitive sport*

- At least 6 external club links identified and used eg; GLK, Dexterity Dance (clubs with an 'onward path') Feb '17
- Review provision of extra-curricular sporting opportunities to ensure a comprehensive range of sport is on offer. Jan '17
- Increase participation in intra and interschool competition (at least one competition involving 'B' teams, 6 intra-school competitions and 5 inter-school competitions) From Sept '16

Informal Activity *Engagement of pupils in regular physical activity*

- Play leaders to be trained and deployed (under direction of sport coach) to increase opportunities for physical activity (lunchtimes) Mar '17

Active Transport *Making active choices when using transport*

- Bikeability for Key Stage 2 pupils Jun '17
