Zoom 2: Tuesday 1st September at 3pm


The zoom meeting ID and password will be sent to your Office 365 emails.

4. Summer activities

You can, of course, have a summer holiday without home learning! If you would like to do some extra activities, you can make something for the classroom and there are some activities you could choose to do to be super prepared for September. You can also add photos of what you get up to over the summer to the Transition channel on Teams if you would like to.

Make something for the classroom

There will be more tables in our classroom in September than we are used to. To make sure we still get to have all the things that make our learning environments cosy and exciting, we are going to hang lots of things from the ceiling. If you choose to make something, aim to make it roughly the size of an A3 piece of paper, make sure you decorate both sides and please make sure it isn't too heavy! Mrs D-S, Mrs Mehrtens and I have made a few examples below. Please bring anything you make into school on the first day back.

Fairy houses

Can you make a fairy home?
Make it as magical and colourful as you can. You could use a carton and cut out the sides (similar to a bird feeder).



Mermaid tails

Create a mermaid tail. You could use cardboard, you could collect lots of different materials and collage, you could paint.



Toys

Once you've completed the 'Topic detective' activity, research a children's toy you could make that fits the topic.



Mobiles

Have a look at pictures of mobiles that hang above children's beds. Can you create one inspired by our topic?



Swords

Make a pirate sword!



Hooks

Can you create a hook or a different shape that might be useful to have on the end of your arm...
