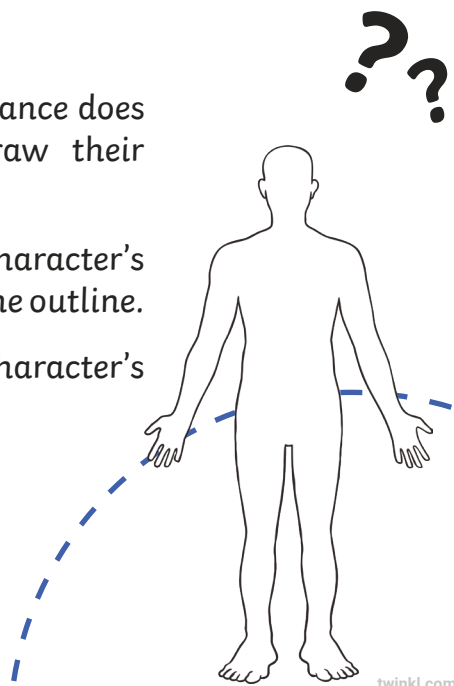

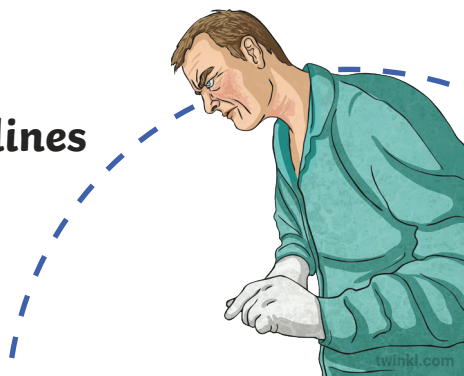

Write about what would happen if the government started to ration electricity.

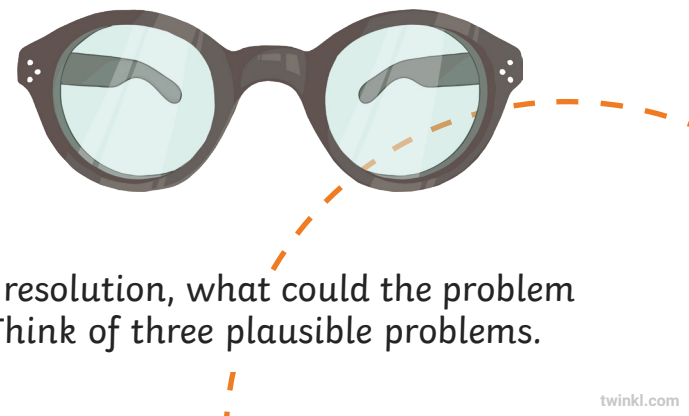

Based solely on their appearance, what name would you give to this character?

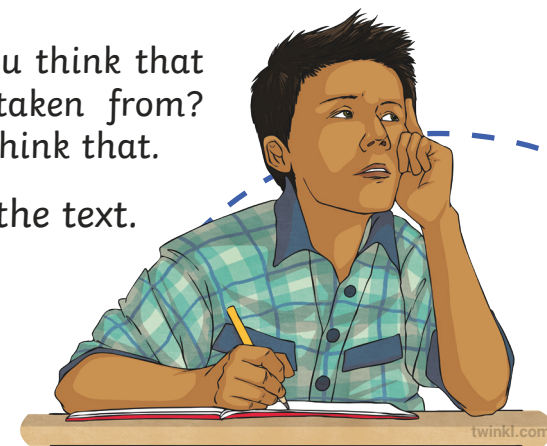
